TRAINING AGREEMENT

Health Care

The dogs in the training program are high quality dogs and it is important each dog be healthy and immunized for your dog's sake as well as the others. Please ask your veterinarian to certify your dog has an up-to-date health record and to provide Side by Side Upland Dog Training with a Certification of Vaccination.

The Veterinarian Certificate must state the dog is free of communicable diseases, has been through the de-worming procedure, has neither internal nor external parasites, and has proof of a negative fecal. **The following vaccinations must be current: bordetella, parvovirus, distemper, adenovirus hepatitis, and leptospirosis.**

In order to reduce the transfer of fleas & ticks the owner must also ensure their dog is **on a monthly flea & tick program.**

Any injury or health-related issue the dog might sustain while in training will be the dog owner's financial responsibility. We will attempt to contact the dog owner if it is believed the dog needs to be seen immediately by a veterinarian; however, if we cannot reach the dog owner we will contact Aumsville Animal Clinic. If they are unable to see the dog, we will then contact an Emergency Vet Clinic.

In order to allow dogs to perform to their fullest ability, Side by Side recommends long-haired dogs be sheared during the summer months.

I, the Dog Owner,

- 1) have read the Health Care Program,
- 2) will provide a Certificate of Vaccination and proof of a negative fecal exam from my veterinarian,
- 3) will maintain a flea & tick program for my dog throughout the training and list the program below,
- 4) will allow Side by Side Upland Dog Training to use their judgement concerning medical care for my dog if they cannot contact me.

The Dog Owner understands dogs sometimes exhibit behavior(s) which cannot reasonably be anticipated by any individual, even one who is very familiar with dogs and dog behavior. The Dog Owner understands there are inherent risks associated with both training and transporting of bird dogs and agrees to defend, fully indemnify, and hold Side by Side Upland Dog Training, LLC, its members, agents, employees, officers, representatives, assigns, and others acting in Side by Side’s behalf entirely free and harmless from any claims, demands, causes of action, and legal liability for any economic or non-economic loss due to bodily injury or infections caused by wounds or inhaling vegetative matter, death, property damage, or any other incident resulting from the care, travel, and training of the animal, except in the event of willful and wanton negligence on the part of Side by Side Upland Dog Training, LLC.

The Dog Owner agrees to defend and hold harmless Side by Side Upland Dog Training LLC, its members, agents, employees, officers, representatives, assigns, and others acting on the Side by Side Upland Dog Training’s behalf from all claims, judgements, damages, penalties, fines, costs, loss, or liabilities in the event Dog Owner’s dog causes harm or injury to 1) any other dog in custody of Side by Side Upland Dog Training, and/or 2) any individual who comes in contact with Dog Owner’s dog while the dog is in custody of Side by Side Upland Dog Training.

The Dog Owner also agrees to defend, fully indemnify, and hold landowners, who have allowed the use of their land for dog training, entirely free and harmless from any claim, judgement, damage, penalty, fine, cost, loss or liability arising out of or related to any activity of Side by Side Upland Dog Training LLC, its members, agents, employees, officers, representatives, assigns, and others acting in Side by Side’s behalf for the benefit of training Dog Owner’s dog and for the Dog Owner, other family member, or friend to attend and participate in any training session.

In the event this Agreement is placed in the hands of an attorney for enforcement, the defaulting party agrees to pay the reasonable costs and expenses of enforcing this Agreement, including reasonable attorney’s fees. In the event a suit or action is filed to enforce this Agreement or to construe or interpret this Agreement, the prevailing party shall be entitled to recover the reasonable costs and expenses of the suit or action, at trial or upon appeal, including reasonable attorney’s fees.

Payment Schedule

In consideration of payment the Owner will receive dog training from a certified Huntsmith dog trainer. Each session offered by Side by Side Upland Dog Training will consist of daily bird contact, and in most cases movement & whoa situations, and obedience training. The dog will also be introduced to the gun report in an appropriate manner. All birds and training supplies will be provided by Side by Side Upland Dog Training.

We train dogs from March 1st through September 1st. There are times we will not train due to holidays or other commitments. Our calendar will be updated with the non-training times in February/March. The training program consists of 60-70 days. Based on several factors: weather, our ability to train, and your ability to bring your dog to training will determine the total number of weeks/months it will take to complete the training of 60-70 days. We do not board dogs so your ability to deliver your dog to us is a key factor. If you are able, we would like for you to attend most sessions. This enhances the management transfer from us to you.

The wild-bird dog-training sessions are set late in the summer.

Pre-payment is required for each 20-day training session and wild- bird dog-training sessions.

Training Sessions & Transportation

Introduction: Meet, program discussion dog evaluation, & ask questions No Fee

Fee Structure: Not all dogs will need the Puppy Introduction training. The Foundation, Intermediate, and Advanced sessions are what it takes to finish your dog. The Alumni events are offered to graduates of the program and are offered in the months of July and August. Alumni are also allowed to set up Tune-up sessions to prepare the dog for the fall hunting season. Wild Bird Training is offered if Dave has room for Alums on his trips to Montana or Central Oregon.
